Airline Baggage Allowances

Most airlines allow one check-in bag plus one carry-on item such as a laptop bag, briefcase, purse or smaller bag. Most airlines let you carry a jacket or hand-held items. A purse may be counted as your personal item, so stow it away into your other bag as you go through check-in.

Most airline guidelines require that packed bags weigh less than 40 or 50 lbs. Remember to always check with your airline for detailed guidelines and for chargers that may apply for checking bags. The US Tour Association has guidelines for carry-on and check-in luggage requirements for different air carriers: www.ustoa.com/consumernews/airlinebaggage.cfm

Packing for Airline Carry-On Bags

Pack prescription medications in the original case with prescription information affixed. You will be required to severely limit the amount of liquids you carry on board. You are expected to carry all on-board liquid toiletries in containers smaller than 3 oz. and all contained within one quart sized transparent plastic bag. This includes gels such as lip gloss, deodorant or chap sticks. There are limitations on other objects you may carry on, and what you may check in. From the EAST:

Take I-264 ramp to Watterson Expressway
Take Watterson Expressway/I-264 W to I-64
Merge onto I-64 W via Exit 19B to Louisville
Take 3rd Street, Exit 5B, to River Road
Downtown
Turn right onto W. River Road
Turn left onto N 4th Street

From the WEST:

Merge onto I-64 E to KY
Take the 9th Street/Roy Wilkins Ave Exit
Exit 4, toward Downtown
Turn Left onto W Market Street/US-31W
E/US-60 Truck E
Turn left onto S 4th Street

Form the SOUTH:

Merge onto I-65 N toward KY
Take Brook Street, Exit 136B
Stay Straight to go onto S Brook Street
Turn Left onto E Muhammad Ali Blvd.
Turn Right onto S 2nd Street/KY-1020
Turn Left onto W Main Street/US-31W
W/US-60 Truck W
Turn Right onto N 4th Street

From the NORTH:

Merge onto I-65 S
Take US-31, Exit 1, to Stansifer Ave 10th St.
Turn Slight Left onto US-31 S to KY
Turn Left onto W Main Street/US-31W
W/US-60 Truck W
Turn Right onto N 4th Street

Parking

Parking is available at the hotel - self parking \$9.00 per day, valet parking \$17.00 per day.

Louisville Ground Transportation

Airport Express Shuttle Service

Fares: \$10 one way

Luxury shuttle limousines are available for customers who have pre-arranged pick up between the hours of 7:00am and 8:00pm. (For Service before 7:00am and after 8:00pm the fee is \$17.) Outside of baggage claim look for the green pillars labeled "HOTEL." For reservations, call the Shuttle Service (502) 366-2628 or visit its website www.sandollarlimo.com

Taxi Service

Fares: \$15.00 - \$20.00

Cabs are available at the traffic island on the left of the taxi stand. Ask at the taxi stand about "Share-a-Ride" to see if anyone else is going your direction. Up to four passengers allowed per taxi ride with the standard rate. In excess of four passengers, the fare increases \$3 per person.

Transit Bus Service

Transit Authority of River City (TARC) buses service the airport. You must have correct change to ride TARC the fare is \$1.25. TARC is located on the traffic island on the east end of the terminal. Take the #2 bus to the Fourth and Market Streets stop. TARC (502) 585-1234.

There is a block and a half walk from the bus stop. Walk north on South Fourth Street toward West Main Street where South Fourth Street turns into North Fourth Street. The Galt House Hotel is at 140 North Fourth Street.
