

## Senior Representative Qualifications

Approved APDT Rally Senior Representatives may present APDT Rally Sanctioned Trial Official's Seminars. Attendance at one seminar every three years is required of all APDT Rally Judges and Representatives (except in cases of extreme hardship as outlined in the Chapter on Continuing Education) and are also open to the general public. Senior Representatives shall be compensated by the APDT in the amount of \$100 for each seminar presented. Please refer to the chapter on Continuing Education for full details.

Applicants for Senior Representative must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a member in good standing of the Association of Pet Dog Trainers.
2. Support the APDT perspective on Rally as a means to encourage a positive relationship of mutual trust and respect between dogs and their owners.
3. Read and understand the APDT Rally Rules, Eligibility and Judging Guidelines. Be thoroughly familiar with the exercises utilized in Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 Rally courses, and maintain familiarity with new competition levels as they are introduced.
4. Qualify in both of the following areas:
  - a. Approved as an APDT Rally Representative.
  - b. Fully approved as an APDT Rally Level 3 judge.
5. Pass the Senior Representative's Test with a score of 90% or higher.
6. Applicants shall fill out the APDT Rally Senior Representative Application Form. The completed application, along with a non-refundable \$15 processing fee, is to be returned to the address indicated on the form.
7. Upon receipt of application and verification of qualifications, the written test will be forwarded to the applicant. The completed test score sheet along with required courses is to be returned to the address indicated.

All applicants will receive prompt notification of their status.
